



SUBSCRIPTION AGREEMENT / TERMS OF SERVICE

The following Terms of Service agreement for PetroChem Wire information products ("PCW") is a legal contract between the undersigned, either an individual of at least 18 years of age or a single entity ("Subscriber" or, collectively, "Users"), and PetroChem Wire, a Delaware LLC located at 10 Lorelei Road, West Orange, New Jersey. This contract is understood to be regarding the Subscriber's use of PCW information services and products. This agreement confirms that the Subscriber agrees to be bound by these Terms of Service and to follow these Terms and all applicable laws and regulations governing the PCW website and all communications materials, applicable on an international basis.

COPYRIGHT AND PERMITTED USE
